## CTE DEMONSTRATION PROJECT GRANT: REQUEST FOR ENGAGEMENT DUE JUNE 1, 2020

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) has released a Request for Engagement (RFE) for the 2020-22 State Career Technical Education (CTE) Demonstration Project Grant. Proposals must be submitted to the WDE by 5 p.m. on June 1, 2020.

The CTE Demonstration Project Grant is a competitive state grant to fund expenses associated with the planning, development and implementation of a new, or the expansion of an existing high school CTE program. The program should prepare high school students for postsecondary options, connect academic and technical curriculum, provide innovation to ensure career choices, work-based learning and dual enrollment, and support workforce, education and the economic needs of Wyoming.

Applicants must be a consortia of, a school district, at least one post-secondary partner, and at least one business or industry partner. Preference will be given to [NextGen partners](#). Grant funds will be awarded for July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022, and must be sustainable after the funding period. The demonstration project maximum cannot exceed \$125,000.
