SUBJECT: Congresswoman Liz Cheney to Speak with Social Studies, Civics and Government Students



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CONGRESSWOMAN LIZ CHENEY TO SPEAK WITH SOCIAL STUDIES, CIVICS AND GOVERNMENT STUDENTS

I invite high school social studies, civics and government teachers and students to join me for another special opportunity to participate in a virtual conversation with a member of Wyoming's congressional delegation. Wyoming U.S. Congresswoman Liz Cheney will speak with students and teachers from 10-11 a.m. MDT on Thursday, April 30 via the Zoom online platform.

This is an opportunity for students to ask questions about current events or about issues discussed in the committees on which she sits, Natural Resources, Armed Services or the House Republican Conference which she chairs.

Teachers who would like their classes to participate on the call can email Thom Gabrukiewicz at thom.gabrukiewicz@wyo.gov to receive the Zoom information. Registration will be required to participate. Teachers should forward the Zoom link and information from the email response from Thom Gabrukiewicz to their students, who will then register for the event using their district-supplied emails.

Teachers should also coordinate with their students if they wish to ask questions of Representative Cheney prior to the meeting. During the call, participants will automatically be muted. Once the meeting starts, students

can use the non-verbal feedback tool in the participant window to raise their hand and their microphone and camera will be unmuted to give them the opportunity to speak.
