RECOGNIZING INSPIRATIONAL SCHOOL EMPLOYEES (RISE) AWARD

Governor Mark Gordon's Office, in partnership with the Wyoming Department of Education (WDE), opened the 2020 application period for the Wyoming RISE award. The new award, passed by Congress in 2019 and overseen by the U.S. Department of Education (USED), honors classified school employees who provide exemplary service.

A classified school employee can be someone who works in any grade, from pre-kindergarten through high school, in any of the following occupational specialties: paraprofessional, clerical and administrative services, transportation services, food and nutrition services, custodial and maintenance services, security services, health and student services, technical services, and skilled trades.

Nominees must, at a minimum, demonstrate excellence in the following areas: Work performance; School and community involvement; Leadership and commitment; Local support (from co-workers, school administrators, community members, etc., who speak to the nominee's exemplary work); Enhancement of classified school employees' image in the community and schools. Letters of recommendation can be cited.
