WYOMING STUDENTS SELECTED TO ATTEND THE 2020 NATIONAL YOUTH SCIENCE CAMP

Governor Mark Gordon has announced that Arundathi Nair and John Pierre have been selected to represent Wyoming at the 2020 National Youth Science Camp (NYSCamp).

Arundathi Nair is a graduate of Laramie High School in Laramie. John Pierre is a graduate of Shoshoni High School in Shoshoni.

The National Youth Science Foundation canceled the in-residence portion of the 2020 National Youth Science Camp. Held in West Virginia since 1963, this is just the second time that the annual program has not been held in the Mountain State.

However, the 108 delegates representing the United States, Mexico, and Trinidad and Tobago will have the opportunity to connect from home for an exclusive virtual program. The 2020 Virtual NYSCamp features a lecture series, directed studies, breakout seminars, special events, and a panel discussion with STEM policy experts.
