Perkins Grant, which aims to increase the retention and concentrator rates of Career and Technical Education (CTE) students and strengthen programs of study at Wyoming school districts. The Perkins Project Coordinator is responsible for the writing and management of the grant to meet target measures and deliverables in accordance with the Wyoming Department of Education, federal regulations, policies and procedures.
