REGISTRATION NOW OPEN FOR JOBSEQ TRAINING

The Carl D. Perkins Grant, Perkins V, is designed to produce high-quality Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs of study for all CTE students. In Wyoming, the tool used to assist in this process is JobsEQ. JobsEQ is software that provides access to labor market data through accurately identifying unique workforce characteristics within communities. The dynamic reports provide current industry and demographic trends, wages, and occupation-specific data by zip code. JobsEQ also provides real-time job postings and resume data useful to all CTE Teachers in assisting students in looking at career opportunities.

This one-hour virtual training provides instruction to Perkins Coordinators at the secondary level, post-secondary personnel who assist with the Perkins V Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment, and CTE teachers, on how to extract valuable data.
