2020-21 WAEA EXCEPTION FORM AVAILABLE NOW

The <u>form</u> for school districts to apply to have its schools exempt from requirements of the Wyoming Accountability in Education Act (WAEA) for the 2020-21 school year is now available. <u>Forms</u> must be submitted by November 13, 2020 in order for the State Board of Education (SBE) to grant exceptions during its November meeting.

Wyoming Statute 21-2-204(d)(vi) gives the SBE the authority to grant an exception to the state's accountability requirements for a school for one school year, when the school demonstrates that it was unable to administer the statewide assessment for good cause. The SBE has determined that the inability to administer the assessment in 2019-20 justifies granting exceptions to state accountability requirements for the 2020-21 school year because of the impact of not having prior year assessment data on several of the accountability indicators, including Growth and Equity. The SBE adopted emergency Chapter 3 rules in October in order to provide a streamlined way for districts to request this exception for the 2020-21 school year.

This exception to the state accountability requirements is the result of a recommendation of the Assessment Technical Advisory Committee that for the 2020-21 school year, Wyoming assess its students to the greatest
