SUBJECT: WDE Awards 21st Century Community Learning Grants

WDE AWARDS \$1 MILLION UNDER THE NITA M. **LOWEY 21ST CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS PROGRAM**

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) has awarded a total of \$1 million for FY 2021 to seven applicants for the Cohort 14 grant competition under Title IV, Part B of the Every Student Succeeds Act, known as the Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers Program (21stCCLC).

The five-year award is to create or expand high-quality after school and summer learning programs serving students attending low performing and high needs schools. There are now a total of 25 organizations with 37 grant awards providing 21stCCLC programs across the state.
