The Wyoming Innovations and Learning Conference will be virtual again this year, with the entire conference offered online. The Innovations conference seeks engaging session proposals from educators in kindergarten through postsecondary education that will be delivered in an online format. The Innovations Planning Committee is seeking presenters from all fields willing to share ideas and experiences to help inspire educators to bring the best teaching practices to K-20 learning.

The fifth-annual Wyoming Innovations in Learning conference is set for September 30 – October 1, 2021.
