REGISTRATION OPEN FOR THE 2021 EMBRACING LITERACY CONFERENCE

The Wyoming Department of Education has opened registration for the second-annual Embracing Literacy Conference, a summer professional development opportunity focused on literacy practices. District- and building-level teams are encouraged to register and attend this opportunity to hear from many national and state literacy experts. The conference theme, "The Science of Reading," provides the foundation for participants to learn more about the components that combine to create literacy. The implementation of screening, progress monitoring and various classroom practices will also be explored.

Embracing Literacy will be held virtually over a three-week span. Virtual sessions will be scheduled for Tuesdays and Thursdays during each week. Registration for the conference is \$25, with an additional \$3.24 for credit/debit card processing.
