CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE) COLLABORATION GRANT OPPORTUNITY

The CTE Collaboration Grant is a competitive state grant that may be used to fund expenses associated with the planning, development and implementation of a new, or expansion of an existing high school CTE program or school facility repairs and improvements to CTE classrooms, shops and labs. Programs funded will provide high school students with postsecondary options, connect academic and technical curriculum, provide innovation to ensure career choices, work-based learning, and support the workforce needs of Wyoming. Applicants must be a consortia of a school district, at least one post-secondary partner, and at least one business or industry partner. Preference will be given to NextGen partners. Grant funds will be awarded no later than August 15, 2021.

The application is available [here](#) and must be submitted by 5 p.m. MDT on June 30, 2021. The funding period is September 30, 2021–September 30, 2023. The program must be sustainable after the funding period. There will be a minimum of four grants awarded. The total amount to be awarded is \$500,000.
