GUIDANCE FOR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN SUBMISSION

For the purposes of annual accreditation and accountability, no school improvement plans will be required by the Wyoming Department of Education for the 2021-22 school year.

Title 1 Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) and Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) schools will still be required to submit a school improvement plan as a component of the 1003(a) grant application to be eligible for 2021-22 funds.

On June 9, 2021, the U.S. Department of Education granted Wyoming's request for one-year amendments and a waiver from reporting. See the attached [letter](#). As a result, no accountability determinations will be made for the 2020-21 school year and Wyoming schools will continue to hold the School Performance Rating and any federal identifications for support they received for the 2018-19 school year.
