## CYBER-IN-A-BOX SCHOOL VIDEO CHALLENGE

Wyoming middle and high school classrooms are encouraged to create new video content promoting public cybersecurity awareness for the [Cyber-in-a-Box Library](#) program.

The [Cyber-in-a-Box School Video Challenge](#) offers teachers \$100 for supplies, and T-shirts for teams of up to five students for entering the challenge. Participants can produce 5-minute videos from September 2021-February 2022, with judging in March and finalists announced in April. In creating the videos, the challenge connects education objectives involving technology, computer science, communication, teamwork and social behavior with enhancing community cyber health and safety practices.
