SUBJECT: 2022-23 Assessment Literacy Training

ASSESSMENT LITERACY TRAINING FOR TEACHERS

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) will engage a cohort of Wyoming educators in discussions about assessment using resources created through a partnership with the National Center for Improvement of Education Assessment. A shared understanding of assessment literacy may improve student learning and achievement.

The goals of the assessment literacy training are to challenge and revise misconceptions about assessment, enhance knowledge about assessment, and provide opportunities to practice appropriate and accurate assessment uses.

Educators will complete pre-recorded modules prior to meeting virtually with WDE staff to engage in assessment discussions. The virtual meetings will be held quarterly and participants will attend all four meetings.
