SUBJECT: American Rescue Plan (ARP) Afterschool and Summer Learning Grants Awarded

ARP ESSER III STRATEGIC AFTERSCHOOL AND SUMMER LEARNING GRANTS AWARDED

Thirteen organizations were awarded \$6.8 million during the first round of funding for the American Rescue Plan (ARP) ESSER III Strategic Afterschool and Summer Learning Grant.

As required by the American Rescue Plan, the Wyoming Department of Education reserved not less than 1% of the state’s total allocation for each federal requirement for evidence-based summer learning programs and evidence-based comprehensive afterschool programs. Both set-asides were combined and awarded to eligible applicants, including school district and community-based organizations in partnership with a school district to offer year-round access to high-quality programs.

The new subgrantees will provide comprehensive afterschool and summer learning programs to students in over 19 communities across the state with the purpose of addressing unfinished learning and other needs brought on by the pandemic. Grant activities will begin during the 2022-23 school year and continue through September 30, 2024.
