TEACHER CLIMATE SURVEY TO OPEN ON MARCH 7, 2023

To better understand the challenges Wyoming educators face, the Wyoming Teacher Retention and Recruitment Task Force has partnered with OMNI Institute to develop and administer a teacher climate survey. The survey is completely anonymous and voluntary. The survey will help the task force learn about educator experiences, and the current educator climate of the workplace. This survey will provide the task force real-time information about the challenges facing educators in Wyoming. The results will help identify actionable strategies at the state and local levels to better meet the needs of Wyoming's teachers.

The teacher climate survey will be sent to teachers on March 7, 2023 and will close on March 17, 2023. The mission of the Retention and Recruitment Task Force will be to develop recommendations for state policymakers, district-level, and school-level staff to increase efforts to positively impact the education workforce.
