21STCCLC GRANT APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 7

Interested applicants for the Cohort 16 competition under Title IV, Part B, the Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21stCCLC), should submit a [Cohort 16 Intent to Apply](#) Google form by Friday, April 7, 2023. This form is not required to apply for a 21CCLC grant, but will be used to communicate with potential applicants about the application process, gaining access to the online grant portal to apply, dates of applicant forums, and any changes to the submission timeline.

As required by federal legislation, the Wyoming Department of Education will give priority to proposals that serve schools identified for comprehensive or targeted support, as well as other low-performing, schoolwide Title I-eligible schools. Schools with less than 25% free and reduced lunch eligibility, direct or feeder pattern calculation, can not be served through this grant.
