CHEYENNE - The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) would like to announce the release of the 2014-2015 National Title I Distinguished Schools Program application. The National Title I Distinguished Schools Program honors Title I schools across the country for their innovation in helping Title I populations achieve high educational standards. These outstanding schools are selected from each state by members of the National Title I Association. They represent superior Title I programs and demonstrate a wide array of strengths. These schools offer focused and innovative professional development opportunities for staff, strong community involvement, and high success with individualized student programs.

Based on applications received, the Wyoming Department of Education will select one qualifying school, if applicable, for this honor in each of the following categories:

- 1. Exceptional student performance for two or more consecutive years; or
- 2. Closing the achievement gap between student groups.

In order to qualify under the above categories, the school must have:

- 1. A poverty rate of at least 35% for the selected year;
- 2. Demonstrated high academic achievement for two or more consecutive years;
- 3. Met or exceeded Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for at least two consecutive years;

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- 4. Clearly demonstrated that it has met the criteria for the category it is applying for; and
- 5. Not been recognized as a Distinguished School during the previous two years.
