State Board of Education to Examine New Legislation During Teleconference on Monday

CHEYENNE – Gaining clarification on new legislation will be a priority for the Wyoming State Board of Education during a teleconference on Monday, March 24, 2014 from 1:00 - 4:00 p.m.

Monday's meeting will be the Board's first since the 2014 legislative session and updates from the session will be at the forefront of this meeting. Among the subjects the board will be updated on include school bus video equipment, changes to the Hathaway Scholarship, and a budget footnote, which discusses the Board's consideration of Next Generation Science Standards. Representatives from the Attorney General's office will be available to offer guidance on the new and revised laws.

In addition to discussion stemming from the 2014 legislative session, the Board will also take action on the selection of a replacement member for the Advisory Committee to the Select Committee on Educational Accountability. In addition, the Board will receive updates on standards adoption and Chapter 10 rules.
