## Do you know where you're going to sleep tonight?

## IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

- In a motel or campground, due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation
- In a car, park, abandoned building or bus/train station
- Doubled up with others due to loss of housing or economic hardship

## Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.



## Your eligible children have the right to:

- Enroll in and attend school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment
- Attend classes locally or continue attending the school in which they were last enrolled, if that is your preference and it is feasible
- Appeal a school district's determination about your child's eligibility for McKinney-Vento services or school selection
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this
- Receive education services comparable to other students, according to your children's needs

*If you believe your children may be eligible, contact the local liaison to find out what services and supports may be available. There also may be supports available for your preschool-age children.*
