# Questions and Answers for the 2021 Wyoming MTSS Center Coaching Institute

The Coaching Institute is a yearlong training provided by the Wyoming MTSS Center. The center is offering ongoing support and guidance for educators responsible for supporting the implementation of Wyoming's Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) at their schools. Participants can attend the in-person, 2day institute and the monthly virtual community of practice meetings to access national experts and resources.

### What Will I Learn?

Coaches will learn and develop the knowledge and skills needed for system-level coaching, including technical knowledge, interpersonal skills, and data-based decision-making skills. They also will learn the infrastructure needed for MTSS implementation and receive guidance and training on developing that infrastructure at their sites.

### What Is the Time Commitment?

The institute is a 2-day workshop combined with monthly meetings with other coaches in the institute. However, nonpilot site coaches are free to attend as little or as much as they can.

## What Will I Do Exactly?

Coaches will develop an action plan for their site that outlines the key goals surrounding MTSS. Generally speaking, coaches will work to develop one of the four components of MTSS at their site, including building the infrastructure to support that component. Coaches also will complete activities as part of the institute and work with their schools to complete activities they choose to support MTSS in their school.

#### What Support Will I Have?

Participants will have access to four state MTSS coaches and a network of other local district system coaches. They also will have ongoing guidance and access to MTSS experts to ask questions, share examples, and network with colleagues.
