## Prepare Students for Success in Wyoming's Future Health Science Workforce

### Provide Opportunities

- Health Care Career programs of study allow Wyoming students to explore careers in Health Sciences.
- Wyoming High School Students can get a jump start on their future career with introductory health science courses ([Wyoming Performance Standards p. 6](#)).
- Instructor pool is broad and inclusive – Wyoming certified health science educators to school nurses holding a [PIC permit](#), no clinical component is required to teach certain programs of study.
- Districts and colleges can share clinical instructors.
- [Dual and concurrent enrollment](#) must meet Wyoming's community college adjunct faculty requirement.

### Prepare Wyoming's Future Health Science Workforce

- [Medical Terminology Courses](#) – Provide Wyoming students with the vocabulary to be successful in health sciences.
- [Basic Emergency Care \(BEC\)](#) – Prepare Wyoming students, 16 years and older, to pursue a postsecondary Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)/Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) course of study.
- [Certified Nurse Aide \(CNA\)](#) – Equip Wyoming students to meet state licensure requirements through working with long term care facilities to meet clinical component requirements. There are even approved online courses for delivering the didactic portion of the course.

### Post-Secondary Student Success

- Pre-requisite courses i.e., anatomy and physiology, nutrition and wellness, and medical terminology can often be met through Secondary Health Science Programs of Study.
- Impact the future of Wyoming's Health Science Workforce.
