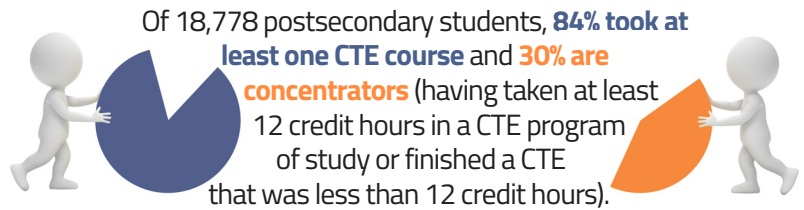

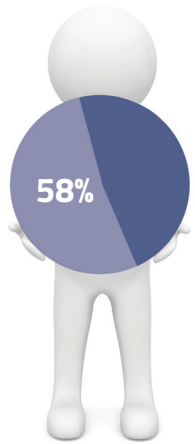

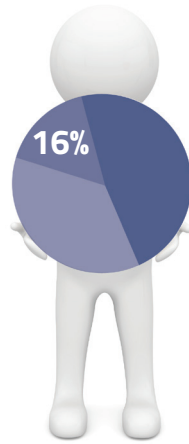

97.9% graduation rate for high-school CTE Concentrators (those having completed at least two courses in a program of study) compared to Wyoming's statewide graduation rate of 82.4%.

84 CTE Teachers completed **4,067.55** externship hours.



Of 28,758 secondary students, **16,707 students took at least one CTE course (58%)** AND **4,695 students (16%) are concentrators.**



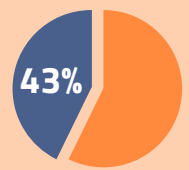

Wyoming students took the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery with an average score of **51.3**

1,719 Industry Recognized Credentials were earned by secondary students, which is **5X** more than earned in 2019-2020.

5,329 students are members of a Career and Technical Student Organization enrolled in 170 chapters.

- 179 students in 10 DECA chapters
- 818 students in 37 FBLA chapters
- 318 students in 32 FCCLA chapters
- 3,726 students in 55 FFA chapters
- 700 students in 36 SkillsUSA chapters

There were **18,778** students enrolled in the fall and spring semester of 2020-2021 in our community colleges. Of those, **8,075** were enrolled in CTE certificate or degree programs.



5,414 high-school students were enrolled in dual and concurrent courses to earn college credit.
