Issues Investigated and Decision:

 Whether the District provided the Student a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) through an Individualized Education Program (IEP) reasonably calculated to provide educational benefit in light of the Student's unique educational and behavioral needs consistent with the requirements of 34 C.F.R. §§300.17 and 300.101.

The Student demonstrated academic and behavioral progress while attending school at the Academy. Therefore, WDE determines that the District provided FAPE, and there is no violation.

2. Whether the District provided the Student with FAPE in the least restrictive environment (LRE) as required by 34 C.F.R. §§300.114 through 300.117.

Because the Student made reasonable progress in the day treatment program at the Academy, the District provided FAPE in the LRE. During the time period relevant to this complaint investigation, the District had no obligation to propose or provide a residential placement. Therefore, there is no violation.
