



2019-2020 & 2020-2021 Public Reporting for Title IV-A

Title IV-A, also known as Student Support and Academic Enrichment (SSAE) grant, is part of the 2015 Every Student Succeeds Act reauthorization of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965. The SSAE program is intended to improve students' academic achievement by increasing the capacity of state educational agencies (SEAs), local educational agencies (LEAs), and local communities to provide all students with:

- Access to a well-rounded education
- Improve school conditions for student learning, promoting safe and healthy students
- Effective use of technology to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students

Wyoming uses a formula grant to ensure all eligible districts in the state that received Title I allocations in the previous school year received funding under Title IV-A. The minimum award is \$10,000. These grants are closed out, and their objectives and intended outcomes have either been achieved or are ongoing via current funding.

LEAs Who Spent Funds Under Title IV-A:

This table shows data on the number of LEAs who spent funds under Title IV, Part A of the ESEA by the content areas. The "Any" category reports the total number of LEAs that spent funds in any of the three content areas. There are 48 school districts in Wyoming, of which 47 were eligible for Title IV-A during both the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years.
