SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-004-23

Decision Date: April 11, 2023

Public Agency: Laramie County School District #1

Issues Investigated and Decision:

1. Whether the District provided the Student a free appropriate public education (FAPE) in conformity with 34 C.F.R. §300.17 and 300.101. Specifically, whether the District reviewed and revised the Student's individualized education program (IEP) to address a lack of progress consistent with 34 C.F.R. §300.324(b) when the Student experienced a lack of progress and declining grades.
2. Whether the District complied with the procedural requirements of IDEA. Specifically,
 - a. Whether the District provided special education services, related services, supplementary aids and services, accommodations, and modifications in conformity with the Student's IEP as required by 34 C.F.R. §§300.320 and 300.324;
 - b. Whether the District provided the Complainant with Prior Written Notice (PWN) as required by 34 C.F.R. §300.503 when amending the Student's IEP;
 - c. Whether the District provided a copy of the Student's IEP to the Complainant as required by 34 C.F.R. §300.322(f); and
 - d. Whether the District provided special education services through a highly qualified teacher in conformity with 34 C.F.R. §300.156.

The Complainant and the District resolved all issues identified in the complaint through a legally binding Settlement Agreement. WDE determines that the Settlement Agreement represents the full resolution of all disputed issues in this complaint.
