Issues Investigated and Decision:

1. Whether the District provided the Student a free appropriate public education (FAPE) consistent with the IDEA and its implementing regulations at 34 C.F.R. §§ 100.17 and 300.101. Specifically,

a. Whether the District developed and implemented an individualized education program (IEP) consistent with the IDEA to address the Student's unique educational needs to enable the Student to be involved in and make progress in the general curriculum as required by 34 C.F.R. § 300.320(a)(2)(i);

WDE finds no violation. The District developed and implemented the Student's IEP consistent with the IDEA.

b. Whether the District reviewed and revised the Student's IEP to address lack of progress as required by 34 C.F.R. § 300.324(b).

WDE finds no violation. The IEP Team reconvened to review and revise the Student's IEP to address the lack of progress that resulted from the Student's attendance.

- 2. Whether the District complied with IDEA's procedural requirements. Specifically,
 - a. Whether the District developed measurable annual goals as required by 34 C.F.R.
 § 300.320(a)(2);

WDE finds no violation. The Student had measurable annual goals based on his unique needs.

- b. Whether the District provided the Complainant with Prior Written Notice (PWN) consistent with 34 C.F.R. § 300.503; and
 - WDE finds no violation. The District provided Prior Written Notice when required.
- c. Whether the District afforded the Complainant the opportunity to meaningfully participate in the IEP process as required by 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.322 and 300.324.
 - WDE finds no violation. The Complainant actively participated in the IEP process.
