SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-001-24

Public Agency: Sheridan County School District #1

Issues Investigated and Decision:

Whether the District proposed an individualized education program (IEP) that offered a free appropriate public education (FAPE) to the Student that was reasonably calculated to provide educational benefit in light of the Student's unique needs consistent with the requirements of 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.17 and 300.101.

During the time of the Student's enrollment in the District, the Student had an IEP in effect that was reasonably calculated to result in educational benefit in light of the Student's unique circumstance. Therefore, there is no violation.
