SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-008-24

Public Agency: Campbell County School District #1

Issues Investigated and Decision:

District Issue #1:

Whether the District provided the Student a FAPE consistent with the IDEA and its implementing regulations at 34 C.F.R. §§ 100.17 and 300.101. Specifically, whether the District developed and implemented an IEP that was reasonably calculated to result in educational benefit in light of the Student's unique education needs consistent with 34 C.F.R. § 300.320; and

WDE finds a violation. Prior to August, the District failed to obtain the necessary medical documentation to develop a plan of care for the use of the helmet and arm bands.

School Issue #1

Whether the School provided special education services and supports in conformity with the Student's IEP as required by 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.17, 300.320 and 300.324.

WDE finds a violation. The School did not provide services and supports as outlined in the Student's IEP when it utilized protective devices and restraints that were not incorporated in the IEP.

The district is required to correct the identified violations via a corrective action plan. The WDE will monitor and document compliance with the corrective action order. Once all corrective action is complete, the WDE will close the case.
