Complaint Case: C-014-24

Public Agency: Fremont County School District #2

Issues Investigated and Decision:

- 1. Whether the District provided the Student a FAPE consistent with the IDEA and its implementing regulations at 34 C.F.R. § 300.17 and 300.101. Specifically,
 - a. Whether the District developed and implemented an IEP that was reasonably calculated to result in educational benefit in light of the Student's unique educational needs consistent with 34 C.F.R. § 300.320.
 - The District developed, implemented, and amended the IEP according to IDEA regulations. A procedural violation occurred when behavior support was documented as special education instead of a supplementary aid and support. This did not result in a denial of FAPE. WDE finds this error to be a procedural violation.
 - b. Whether the District provided special education placements for the Student in conformity with the LRE requirements pursuant to 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.114 through 117.
 - The District provided special education placement for the Student in conformity with the LRE. WDE finds no violation.
 - c. Whether the District afforded the Student all protections for disciplinary removals under the IDEA consistent with 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.530 through 300.536.

The District provided the Student with disciplinary protections, including conducting a manifestation determination when required. WDE finds no violation.

The district is required to correct the identified violations via a corrective action plan. The WDE will monitor and document compliance with the corrective action order. Once all corrective action is complete, the WDE will close the case.
