SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-019-24

Public Agency: Natrona County School District #1

Issues Investigated and Decision:

1. Whether the District provided the Student a free appropriate public education (FAPE) consistent with the IDEA and its implementing regulations at 34 C.F.R. §§ 100.17 and 300.101. Specifically,
 - a) Whether the District developed an individualized education program (IEP) that was reasonably calculated to result in educational benefit in light of the Student's unique educational needs consistent with 34 C.F.R. § 300.320;
 - b) Whether the District provided services and supports, including services when the Student was home attending online school, in conformity with the Student's IEP as required by 34 C.F.R. § 300.17; and
 - c) Whether the District ensured that a continuum of alternative placements was available to meet the needs of the Student to provide FAPE based on the Student's unique educational needs pursuant to 34 C.F.R. § 300.115.

The Parents and the District resolved all issues identified in the complaint through a legally binding Mediation Agreement. WDE determines that the Mediation Agreement represents the full resolution of all disputed issues in this complaint. No further action is warranted, and the complaint is deemed closed.
