SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-005-25

Public Agency: Laramie County School District 1

Issues Investigated and Decision:

1. Whether the District provided the Student a FAPE pursuant to 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.17 and 300.101 when ESY services were unilaterally reduced in May and June 2024 after the IEP team determined the amount and type of services that were reasonably calculated to result in educational benefit in light of the Student's unique educational needs consistent with 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.320 and 300.324.

WDE finds no violation. ESY services were determined through the IEP process based on the Student's unique needs.

2. Whether the District complied with the IDEA's procedural requirements. Specifically,
 - a. Whether the District provided the Complainant the opportunity for meaningful participation in IEP team meetings when determining ESY services necessary to provide FAPE to the Student consistent with 34 C.F.R. § 300.501.

WDE finds no violation. The Complainant actively participated in the determination of ESY services.

- b. Whether the District provided the Complainant with prior written notice regarding the decision to reduce ESY hours consistent with 34 C.F.R. § 300.503.

WDE finds no violation. The District provided the Complainant with prior written notice proposing ESY as determined by the IEP team.
