Issues Investigated and Decision:

Whether the District proposed an IEP reasonably calculated to result in

educational benefit based on the Student's unique educational needs as required

by 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.17 and 300.101 when reducing the amount of time to

complete assignments on or about November 15, 2024.

WDE finds no violation. The November 15, 2024, IEP includes the extended

time the Student required as determined through the IEP process based on

the Student's unique needs.

2. Whether the District complied with IDEA's procedural requirements. Specifically,

a. Whether the District provided services, specifically, the accommodation of

additional time to complete assignments in conformity with the Student's

IEP as required by 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.17(d), and 300.320(a)(4); and

WDE finds no violation. Services were provided in conformity with the

Student's IEP.

b. Whether the District provided the Complainant with the opportunity to

participate in the IEP process and IEP team decisions, consistent with 34

C.F.R. §§ 300.324(a) and 300.501, when the District developed and

implemented a parent communication plan.

WDE finds no violation. The Complainant actively participated in the

IEP process and IEP team decisions, including after the District

developed and implemented a parent communication plan.

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
