SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-017-25

Public Agency: Park County School District 6
Board of Cooperative Educational Services 5

Issues Investigated and Decision:

District Issue #1:

Whether the District provided the Student a FAPE consistent with the IDEA and its implementing regulations at 34 C.F.R. §§100.17 and 300.101. Specifically, whether the District developed and implemented an IEP that was reasonably calculated to result in educational benefit in light of the Student's unique educational needs consistent with 34 C.F.R. §300.320;

WDE finds no violation. The District ensured the Student was provided FAPE through a properly developed and implemented IEP.

District Issue #2:

Whether the District provided the Complainant with the opportunity to meaningfully participate in the IEP process and IEP team decisions, including the Student's special education supports, services, and placement consistent with 34 C.F.R. §§300.322, 300.324(a), and 300.327.

WDE finds no violation. The Complainant was an active participant in the IEP process and team decision making.

District Issue #3:

Whether the District ensured special education placement in conformity with the least restrictive environment (LRE) requirements consistent with 34 C.F.R. §§300.114 through 300.116 when the Facility removed the Student from her current educational placement through the use of seclusion as defined in Wyoming Statute (W.S.) §21-2-202 (a)(xxxii) and W.S. §21-3-110(a)(xxxi) and WDE Chapter 42 Seclusion and Restraint in Schools.

WDE finds no violation. The WDE lacks jurisdiction over matters that did not occur in school.

Facility Issue #1

Whether the Facility provided special education services and supports in conformity with the student's IEPs, including the use of seclusion as required by 34 C.F.R. §§300.17, and 300.320 through 300.324, Wyoming Statute (W.S.) §21-2-202 (a)(xxxii) and W.S. §21-3-110(a)(xxxi) and WDE Chapter 42 Seclusion and Restraint in Schools.

WDE finds no violation. The WDE lacks jurisdiction over matters that did not occur in school.
