SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-039-24

Public Agency: Johnson County School District #1

Issues Investigated and Decision:

1. Whether the District provided REDACTED students with disabilities receiving services in the REDACTED Classroom a FAPE consistent with the IDEA and its implementing regulations at 34 C.F.R. §§ 100.17 and 300.101. Specifically,

- a. Whether the District developed and implemented an IEP that was reasonably calculated to result in educational benefit in light of each student's unique educational needs consistent with 34 C.F.R. § 300.320.

WDE finds no violation. IEPs for REDACTED students in the REDACTED classroom were developed and implemented consistent with student need.

- b. Whether the District provided special education a placement in conformity with the LRE requirements pursuant to 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.114 through 117.

WDE finds no violation. The District provided placement as required. The concern specific to Student was a misunderstanding between placement and location.

2. Whether the District complied with IDEA's procedural requirements. Specifically,

- a. Whether the District provided services consistent with IEPs as required by 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.17(d) and 300.320.

WDE finds no violation. Services were provided consistent with IEPs.

- b. Whether the District made decisions regarding the provision of ESY services for students consistent with 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.106, 300.320 through 300.324.

WDE finds no violation. ESY services were determined based on student need.

- c. Whether the District provided special education and related services through fully certified staff that meet the requirements outlined in 34 C.F.R. § 300.156.

WDE finds no violation. School personnel were adequately licensed, supervised and trained.

- d. Whether the District convened IEP teams with required team membership as outlined in 34 C.F.R. § 300.321.

WDE finds no violation. IEP team meetings were convened with required team membership.

- e. Whether the District informed staff of their responsibilities related to implementing IEPs as required by 34 C.F.R. § 300.323(d).

WDE finds no violation. Staff were informed of their responsibilities related to implementing IEPs for students with whom they worked.
