SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-003-26

Public Agency: Fremont County School District #6

Issues Investigated and Decision:

1. Whether the District provided the Student a FAPE in conformity with 34 C.F.R. § 300.17 and 300.101. Specifically,

- a. Whether the District developed an IEP reasonably calculated to enable the Student to make progress appropriate in light of their circumstances, pursuant to 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.114; 300.320; and 300.324.

WDE finds a violation. The IEP is not reasonably calculated to enable Student to make progress appropriate in light of their circumstances.

- b. Whether the District properly implemented the Student's IEP according to its terms, pursuant to 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.320 through 300.324.

WDE finds no violation. District properly implemented Student's IEPs according to the terms.

2. Whether the District complied with the procedural requirements of IDEA. Specifically,

- a. Whether the Complainant was provided a meaningful opportunity to participate in the development of the Student's IEP, pursuant to 34 C.F.R. § 300.324(a)(1).

WDE finds no violation. Complainant was afforded a meaningful opportunity to participate in the development of the Student's IEP.

The district is required to correct the identified violations via a corrective action plan. The WDE will monitor and document compliance with the corrective action order. Once all corrective action is complete, the WDE will close the case.
