SPECIAL EDUCATION COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION

Complaint Case: C-009-26

Public Agency: Fremont County School District #6

Issues Investigated and Decision:

1. Whether the District provided the Student a FAPE in conformity with 34 C.F.R. § 300.17 and 300.101. Specifically,
 - a. Whether the transportation services provided under the Student's individualized education program (IEP) are reasonably calculated to meet Student's transportation needs, pursuant to 34 C.F.R. §§ 300.34 and 300.320(a)(4).

WDE finds a violation. The IEP team should have reviewed the transportation protocol to ensure it was addressing Student's needs.

2. Whether the District complied with the procedural requirements of IDEA. Specifically,
 - a. Whether the Complainant was provided a meaningful opportunity to participate in the development of the Student's IEP, pursuant to 34 C.F.R. § 300.324(a)(1).

WDE finds no violation. Complainant was afforded a meaningful opportunity to participate in the development of the Student's IEP.

The district is required to correct the identified violations via a corrective action plan. The WDE will monitor and document compliance with the corrective action order. Once all corrective action is complete, the WDE will close the case.
